SPITI VALLEY
09 NIGHTS / 10 DAYS
EX CHANDIGARH

Places Covered: Sarahan, Sangla, Chitkul, Tabo, Kalpa, Kaza, Chandratol, Manali

Day 01: Arrive Chandigarh – Spiti Valley Chandigarh - Sarahan (275 Km) Welcome to Chandigarh, and be ready for a wonderful journey to “Spiti Valley” Situated at an altitude of 12,500 feet above sea level, the picturesque valley encased by the Himalayas is an exotic destination and gem of Himachal Pradesh. Snow crest alps, snow carpeted pristine landscape, alpine forest, deep ravines speckled with greenery, glistening glaciers, sparkling azure rivers, splendid monasteries and quaint hamlets embellish the valley and exude a vision of a mesmerizing painting. Spiti Valley is an exquisite cold mountain desert in the lap of the Great Himalaya Ranges in Himachal Pradesh. Spiti literally means the middle land; and is aptly named, as Spiti Valley separates India from Tibet. At Chandigarh Airport or Railway station our Driver will meet you and drive you to Sarahan by road. Located halfway up a high mountain side, the road to Sarahan winds past flowering Pine trees that give way to stately Oaks. Dozens of small streams rush past. The fields and orchards that surround the small villages with their slate roofed houses, compose pictures of pastoral perfection. Above Sarahan, a many deodar trees rides the slopes and higher still, encircling the Bashal peak, are trees of smooth birch and variety of wild flowers and rare medicinal herbs. This sparsely populated tract is steeped in ancient legends and here is the famous Bhimakali temple regarded as one of the 51st sacred Thirtieths. The temple’s unusual architecture and wealth of carvings have made it a resplendent example of what is loosely called the Indo-Tibetan style. Deep down the alley flows the river Sutlej and across lies the snow-clad Shrikhand peak. Upon arrival check in at the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel

Day 02: Sarahan- Sangla Drive to Sangla (85 kms) After Breakfast proceed to Sangla, one of the most charming valleys in the whole Kinnaur District, Sangla Valley is a perfect getaway from the hustle bustle of the swarming cities. Sangla Valley is also known as Baspa valley since Baspa River flow through the area. Upon arrival check in at the hotel. later visit Kamru Fort beautifully carved old temples and Buddhist monasteries. You will have plenty of opportunity to speak to the local people in these valleys. Overnight stay at the hotel

Day 03: Sangla Excursion to Chitkul After breakfast Visit Chitkul Last inhabited village on the Indo – Tibet border. Chitkul is mainly known for its mesmerizing beauty and bucolic nature. The picturesque location and the scenic beauty of the place are what draws travellers towards it. Spend your Day here and enjoy the mesmerizing view. Later back to Sangla. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 04: - Sangla - Kalpa Drive to Kalpa (40 Km) After breakfast proceed to Kalpa a beautiful hill station with some breath-taking views of snow peak. The small township retains a traditional ambience. Enroute visit Reckongpeo the district headquarters of Kinnaur. Later proceed to Kalpa. Upon arrival Check into your Hotel.

Later Visit area around Kalpa, Visit Suicide Point, Roghi Village The finest view of Mt. Kinner Kailash Mountain (6000 metres) can be seen from Kalpa. This is a spectacular sight early in the morning as the rising sun touches the snowy peaks with crimson and gold light. Overnight stay at hotel

Day 05: Kalpa to Tabo Drive to Tabo (165 Km) After breakfast drive to Tabo, the cold desert town situated at an elevation of 10,760 feet and is surrounded by scree slopes and snow-capped peaks of the Himalayas. On the way visit Nako. Nako has a beautiful lake which freezes in the winter and villagers play ice hockey during this period and seeing the temple of Padamsambhava, the second incarnation of lord Buddha who made Buddhism popular in the Trans Himalayas. Later Proceed to Tabo and visit Gue village home to the 550 years old mummy which makes your journey exciting. Evening reach Tabo and check in to your hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 06 Tabo Sightseeing and Drive to Kaza Drive to Kaza (48 Km) After breakfast Checkout and ready for Tabo Sightseeing. Visit Tabo Monastery and Tabo Caves - Tabo Gompa, locally known as Tabo Chos-Khor Monastery, is a Buddhist monastery complex consisting of nine sub-temples. It was founded in 996 AD and is considered to be the oldest functioning Buddhist monastery in the country. The walls inside are decorated with paintings, statues, murals, thangka art, and frescoes. The monastery complex also includes cave shrines and four decorated stupas. Visit Tabo Caves – Cave is part of the 1000-year old monastery complex, the spectacular Tabo caves are clearly visible on the hillside. These artificially built caves once served as dwellings for monks who used these to escape the harsh Himalayan winters.

Later Proceed to Kaza enroute visit Dhankar Monastery Strategically built at highest location in Spiti Valley, Dhankar Monastery was once the capital of Spiti in 17th century. Dhankar Monastery is also known as Dhangkar Gompa or Dhankhar and was built around 1000 years ago. It was also known as Lha-od Gompa after it's founder and renovator, Lha-od, who was a popular lama. It is one of the five main Buddhist centres and tourist destinations in Spiti region. This monastery is the main center of Buddhist culture and houses the collection of centuries-old thanksas. Upon arrival in Kaza check in at your hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 07: Kaza Sightseeing After breakfast Visit Langza village. Langza village is one of the most fascinating places to see in Spiti Valley. This is a picturesque village which offers a number of tourist attractions in the form of prehistoric buildings and ancient monasteries. Later drive to Hikkim, and the Komic village. Hikkim is known for housing world's highest post office and Komic Known to be the highest village in the world, Komic is located in the beautiful Spiti Valley at an altitude of 15500 ft. Later back to Kaza. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 08: Kaza - Chandratul Lake Drive to Chandratul (96 Km)
Morning after breakfast proceed to Chandratul lake. Chandratul Lake is reckoned as the most charismatic lake situated in the laps of Himalayas. The lake is crescent-shaped, and that is how it got its name. Drive to Chandratul via Kunzum Pass, Kunzum Pass is a beautiful mountain pass located at an altitude of 15,060 feet above sea level, the Kunzum Pass is a breath-taking sight to behold. One of the exciting features of the pass is the fifteen hairpin turns along the way. The Kunzum Pass is one of the highest motorable passes of India and acts as a connection link between the Lahaul Valley and the Spiti valley. On arrival check in at hotel / camp. Overnight stay at Batal or /Chandratul

Day 09: - Chandratul Lake - Manali Drive to Manali (140 kms) Enjoy beautiful and mesmerizing view around Chandratul lake. Later drive to Manali by road Manali is a perfect hill station covered with snow mountains and beautiful water falls. Drive through Atal tunnel and reach Manali. Upon arrival check in at the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel
